### **AICP Exam Orientation Scheduled**

December Meeting, Spring Workshops to Help AICP Hopefuls Prepare for the Big Test

Planners who intend to take the May 1987, American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) exam are invited to attend an orientation meeting which will be held on December 11, from 6:00 - 7:00 p.m., in Room 2143 Wurster Hall, University of California, Berkeley. The purpose of this meeting is to acquaint prospective exam takers with the scope of the examination, the application process and exam preparation workshops offered by Northern Section in April 1987.

Persons interested in taking the AICP exam, successful completion of which is a pre-requisite to AICP membership status, should write directly to AICP, 1776 Massachusetts Ave., N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036 to request a copy of the application form. (Persons who are not members of the American Planning Association should also request an APA membership application form.)

Application for the AICP exam is a two-step process. Prospective exam takers must first apply to AICP for a determination of their eligibility to take the exam. This application, copies of which will be available at the orientation meeting, accompanied by a \$20 or \$30 fee, must be received by AICP by January 26, 1987. Generally, persons with a Bachelor's or a graduate degree in planning and four or more years of professional planning experience are eligible to take the AICP exam.

Persons determined to be eligible

to take the exam will be sent detailed information on the written exam along with the exam registration form. This form, accompanied by a \$150 fee, must be returned to AICP by March 31, 1987. The administration of the exam will occur during the week of May 11-16 at a local test center.

The Section also sponsors a series of free preparatory workshops, tentatively scheduled for April 21 and 28, 1987. Each workshop will be held from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. in Room 214B Wurster Hall, UC Berkeley. Advance registration is mandatory for admission. Register by bringing three stamped self-addressed legal size envelopes to the orientation meeting, or by mailing them to Fred Etzel, Henn, Etzel & Mellon, Two Embarcadero Center, 16th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94111, by March 1, 1987.

The two workshops will focus on taking practice exams which attempt to duplicate the format of the actual three-hour, 150-question, multiple choice AICP exam.

Special thanks is due to Jean Nesick, AICP, who helped compile the two practice exams used in the 1986 workshops.

Persons who passed the AICP exam last year are urgently needed to assist in preparing practice exams. Please call Fred Etzel at 415/392-4600 immediately.
