Then we'll explore how they can support district engagement and goal setting.

Of course, real change doesn't happen in a vacuum—each project is uniquely suited to its specific community. We'll provide the practical training you need to start putting the Framework into practice.

DISTRICT ORGANIZATION:

District-scale sustainability comes in many shapes and sizes. So, what are a project's boundaries? Who are its stakeholders, and how do they interact with each other? We'll walk you through the critical questions and explore the community engagement each project needs.

DISTRICT ASSESSMENT:

What project priorities make the most sense for a district? We'll discuss the elements of an intensive neighborhood assessment and show how it can create neighborhood-driven, appropriate change. Learn about the EcoDistricts Performance Areas' distinct set of visions, goals and targets that unites sustainable neighborhoods across diverse communities.

DISTRICT PROJECTS:

Public-private-civic partnerships are essential. Find out what's behind the alignment and coordination of district stakeholders, private developers, public agencies and utilities to move project feasibility and development to a reality.

DISTRICT MANAGEMENT:

Find out how the Performance Areas can shape data collection for effective long-term stakeholder-driven management and ongoing improvement.
