This application shall be emailed as a PDF to awards@norcalapa.org.

The application PDF shall be labeled in the following format:

For example, a project called "Awesome Project", prepared by "Stellar Consultant" is applying for the "Transportation Planning Award". Their application PDF would be titled, "Transportation Planning Award 2025 Awesome Project Stellar Consultant".

A minimum of three (3), and up to eight (8) high resolution (minimum 150DPI) photos, diagrams, illustrations, or graphic project materials that showcase the nominated project/plan <u>must be</u> <u>uploaded to a sharefile link</u>, which is to be <u>included in the submittal email</u> with your application. Please ensure the sharefile link is valid for anyone with the link, until at least June 30th. The sharefile link shall include individual JPEG files, labeled 'PROJECTNAME_PHOTO#'. Note, photos may also be included in the PDF application; however, the requirement for a sharefile link with individual JPEG files is a requirement.
